Two of the top priced pens of Merryville cfa superfine ewes were added to the flock in 1999 and 2000. At Main Range we aim to breed a balanced merino, with equal emphasis placed on constitution and body size and also on the production of long soft stapled, superior performing wools. To accomplish this aim, the cutting ability and commercial performance of Cottage Park (flock no. 2300)genetics have been used to complement the beautiful wools from Demondrille (flock no. 3994)stud rams.

Annual Comment - Welcome to Boudjah 2024.

With a return to a more normal rainfall we were able to sow turnips early in the New Year.
Having turnips enabled me to have the rams on crop from May to just recently. They have done well as is reflected in their August body weights.
The other pleasing result was to have a run of Merino lambs, shorn and on crop from May until July.
These lambs were sold in Wagga in early July for a top price of \$177.00 per head. Coupled with the wool at 16.8 micron, made a return of around \$200.00 per head at 10 to 11 months of age.
The growing recognition of the eating quality of Merino Lamb/Hogget meat is adding a very important component to the Merino Industry.
Rams were shorn on the 12th of February and again on the 3rd May.
This enable wool weights ,mainly for on property use ,to be collected and for sale day observation of body shape and muscling.
Boudjah will not have rams at the Cooma Showground for Open day on Sunday October 20th as it is my intention to visit other Monaro Merino Studs whose rams I have not seen for some years.
Rams are available at Kybeyan for pre sale inspection.

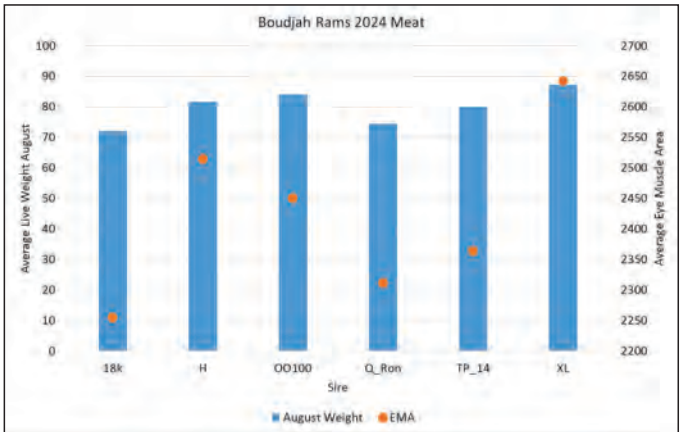
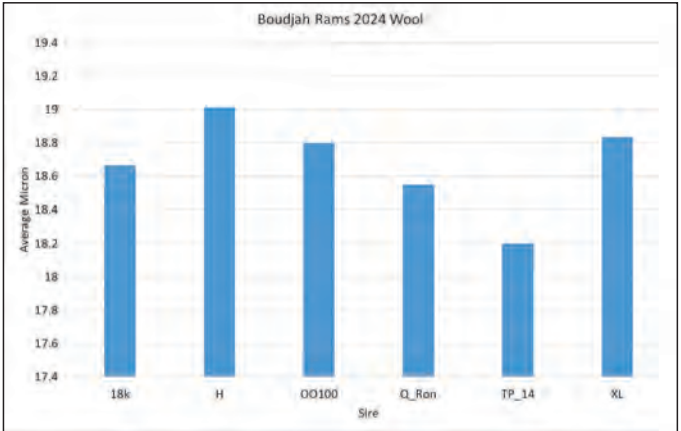

CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. Subject to a vendor's reserve price the highest bidder shall be the purchaser, and in the event of any dispute arising it shall be settled by the auctioneer nominates, and the auctioneer unless one of the claimants will advance in which case the lot or lots shall be put up again. No bidder shall bid a sum less than the auctioneer nominates, and the auctioneer shall have the right to refuse any bid without giving any reason therefore. Stock passed in at Auction will remain available on the day for an extra \$50 above vendors reserve.
2. The purchaser shall deposit the whole or any part of the purchase money if required at any time during the sale.
3. All stock shall be paid for in cash immediately on conclusion of the sale and prior to delivery, but in the event of delivery being made or possession obtained by the purchaser or his representative prior to payment of the purchase money such delivery of possession shall be pro forma only and until payment is full of the purchase money or any cheque given on account of same the purchaser shall hold the stock as bailee only for the vendor and (notwithstanding anything therein to the contrary) no property there in shall pass to the purchaser who shall nevertheless be responsible for the safety thereof. Notwithstanding such delivery or possession payment is due immediately on each lot being knocked down and if payment is not made at the abovementioned time the vendor or his agent shall be at liberty to repossess forthwith and for that purpose to enter upon lands or premises of the purchaser.
4. All stock shall be at the risk and expense of the purchaser upon the fall of the hammer.
5. The vendor reserves the right of making one bid for each lot.
6. All conditions and warranties expressed or implied by law are hereby excluded and as all lots are open for inspection prior to the commencement of the sale the same are sold with all faults, if any, whether visible or not, therefore no compensation shall be made in respect of any faults or imperfections or error of description or number in or of any lots sold or otherwise.
7. If the purchaser shall neglect or fail to comply with any of the above conditions any stock knocked down to him may be resold by public auction or private contract with or without notice at his risk and he will be held responsible for all loss and expense arising out of such resale and shall not participate in the profit (if any) accruing there from.
8. It shall be lawful for the purchaser to authorise the auctioneer and/or the auctioneer's clerk to sign on his behalf the Contract of Sale which shall embody these conditions of sale and on the purchaser's behalf to pay or accept responsibility for payment to vendor(s) of the purchase money so that immediate delivery (which shall be pro forma only) may be facilitated. As between vendor, auctioneer and purchaser it is agreed:
 - (a) The purchaser shall immediately reimburse the auctioneers all monies so paid or for which responsibility has been accepted.
 - (b) Pending such reimbursement the stock are mortgaged and charged to the auctioneer to secure such reimbursement and failing such reimbursement the auctioneer shall be entitled to repossess immediately.
 - (c) Without prejudice to any rights powers and remedies the auctioneer shall have all those conferred on a vendor by the preceding clauses.

Boudjah Ram Check

On Sunday the 15th September 2024, a veterinary examination was conducted of this year's Boudjah Sale Rams. The aim of the "Vet Check" is to ensure that all rams are fit and fertile for sale time. This examination has been carried out on Boudjah rams for over 20yrs, so clients can be confident that rams are satisfactory and that they are meeting exceptional standards.

They

are scrutinized by a team of people; veterinarians and graziers, along with wool industry experts.

The veterinary side of the process starts as the rams are walking into and around the yards. This allows examination of overall soundness, and body condition score; with any generalized

remarks noted.

Each ram is individually assessed during the exam on a variety of aspects, most relating to fertility and ability to work, but also general health and biosecurity risks.

Each ram is individually identified with an electronic tag (located in the ear). This is recorded alongside their exam results.

Body Condition Score (BCS) is the first examination point as the ram enters the sheep handler. This allows for a general assessment of the overall health of the animal. If it seems to "fit in" with the rest of the mob, it inadvertently tells us that it's eating well and there isn't any grave health issue. Rams should be at a BCS of no less than 3 (on a 1 to 5 scale), trending toward 4 before joining.

Eyes are assessed for clarity and to make sure no growths, injuries or irritations are present.

We then move onto what is deemed to be the **most important part** of a Ram examination; **the 4 Ts**.

Teeth - This allows identification of age. The mouth and oral cavity are also assessed for any lesions/injuries. During examination of the teeth, the cheeks and nose are also assessed due to proximity to the area.

Toes - The feet are examined to assess conformation, redness/irritation, purulent discharge, under-running of sole or foul smelling discharge. This helps rule out abscess formations and foot rot. A normal foot has a hard wall of horn around two toes, each with a softer sole horn at the base. A healthy foot has pale pink and dry interdigital skin. A healthy foot will also show no abnormalities of horn growth.

Foot shape and structure are crucial in picking rams, when

thinking about the amount of walking they do during breeding season. It is also critical when thinking about footrot, as structure and shape affect susceptibility.

During examination of the feet, the legs are also assessed.

Testicles - This is all about palpation of the testicles and underlying structures along with scrotal circumference.

Uniformity and firmness of the testicles is vitally important, soft flabby testicles are usually an indication of poor fertility.

The scrotum is assessed for thickenings/injuries or abscesses that are likely to interfere with cooling (vital in sperm

production). The spermatic cords are palpated for swellings/abscesses. The head, body and tail of the epididymis

are again assessed for swellings/abnormalities that will likely interfere with movement of sperm from testicles to the penis.

If everything palpates normally, a scrotal circumference

measurement is taken. Scrotal circumference is correlated to daily sperm production. Larger testicles in sires are shown to

have positive effects on daughters they produced. These

daughters are likely to reach puberty earlier and ovulate more ova each cycle.

Any animal with a scrotal circumference of less than 32cm is removed.

Tossle (penis) - this is started by assessment of the prepuce for any damage, making sure the penis can protrude. The penis is

then exteriorized and assessed for redness/sores along with any obvious injuries or infections.

Any animal deemed to have failed any aspect of the

examination is removed from the sale team. Every effort has been made to keep these animals isolated between inspection

and sale.

The above examination is a time specific examination and thus it is recommended that once rams are home and settled in; they

again be examined prior to joining. We recommend that this

occurs 6-8wks before joining, and be done on an annual basis.

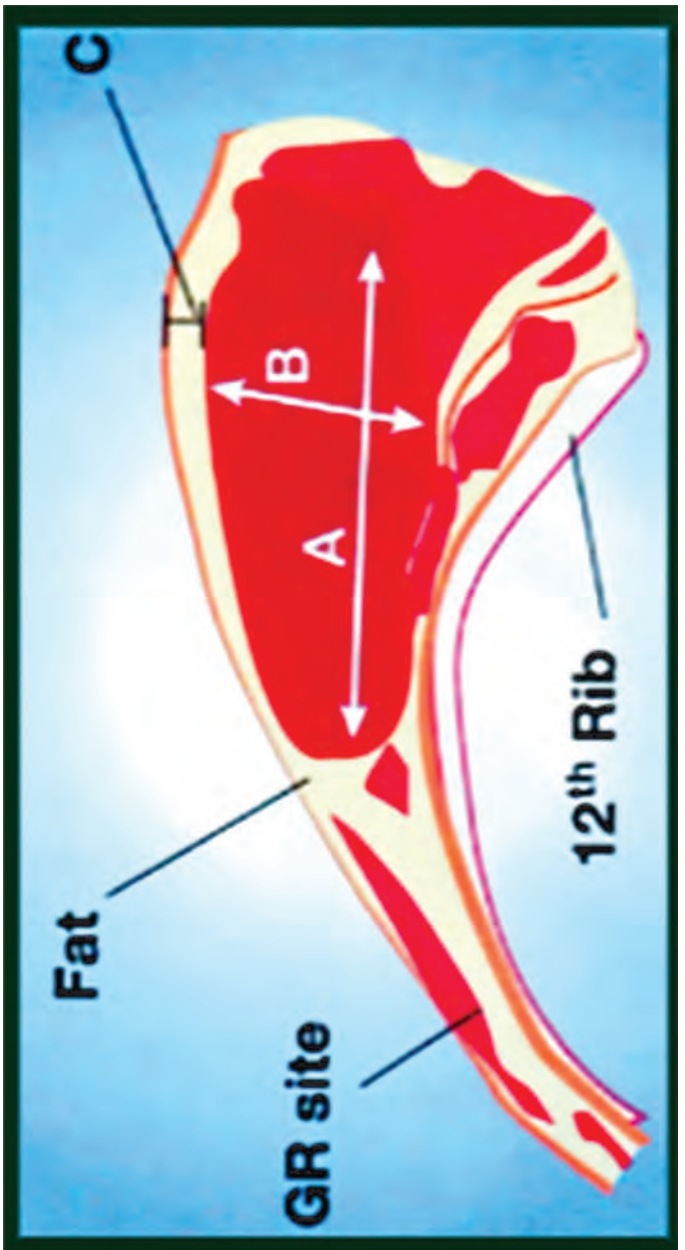

Rick Power came on board as the Boudjah Stud Advisor in 2014. To ensure the Boudjah flock is measured as a modern Merino, Michael took the opportunity to commence scanning the Boudjah Rams for Eye Muscle Area (eye muscle depth and width) and fat score. Intra Muscular fat is obvious on the screen however it is unable to be recorded.

Scanning is also a good opportunity for Rick to observe every ram as an individual and his Scanners Choice is recorded by his “tick” system.



An ultrasound scanner is used and the wool is parted and combed to allow access to the skin in the loin region.
